TIP	POTENTIAL SAVNGS
Adjust sprinklers to prevent overspray and runoff.	15-25 gallons/day
Repair leaks & broken sprinkler heads.	10 gallons/minute/leak
Add 2" to 3" of mulch around trees & plants to reduce evaporation.	20-30 gallons/day per 1,000 sq. ft.
Upgrade to a "smart irrigation controller" that automatically adjusts watering times for hotter weather, and shuts down the system when it rains.	40 gallons/day
Use a broom instead of a hose to clean driveways and sidewalks.	8-18 gallons/minute
Install covers on pool and spas to reduce evaporation.	30 gallons/day
Wash only full loads of clothes.	15-50 gallons/load
Fix leaky toilets.	30-50 gallons/day per toilet
